# Answering Your Questions

The announcement of a new technology platform coming this fall has generated a number of questions. Between now and the launch, we will try to answer the most common ones.

Q: Will my information be secure?

A: Yes! In fact, your data will now be more secure than ever before. Our technology provider's goal is to make their entire community of users feel that every possible measure has been taken to ensure security. Security systems are in place at three levels: the data itself, the application, and at the network operations center where the data is stored. For example, the data center provider is SAS 70 Type II certified and employs biometric scanners, 24/7 on-site personnel and video surveillance. triple door access (through two kevcard doors and one physical key door for access), plus locked server rack access.

It is also important to note there are no social security or credit card numbers nor bank account information stored in this database.
