Be a Hero. Save a Life.

With yet another superhero blockbuster on the horizon, we're once again reminded that heroes often save lives, but you don't need a cape or special powers to be a hero. On Monday, April 9, from 1-7pm, you can save a life by donating blood at Central's semi-annual blood drive. Actually, your single donation can save up to THREE lives. That's even better than the Avengers!

Every two seconds someone in the United States needs blood. Blood donation is a simple four-step process: registration, medical history and mini-physical, donation, and refreshments. The actual blood donation typically takes less than 10-12 minutes. The entire process, from the time you arrive to the time you leave, takes about an hour and 15 minutes. Do you have 75 minutes to spare if it can save three lives?
