Serve Sundays

On a typical Sunday morning, more than 800 people come through our doors to worship, pray, learn, and enjoy the company of friends. Many also come to serve. It is through the generous gift of their time that all the other things we enjoy about Sunday mornings are possible, and several of our teams have an urgent need for help. Please prayerfully consider how you might participate in "serve Sundays" at Central.

Ushers - Ushering is a simple but powerful way to make people feel welcome and at home at Central. The team at the 10:45 (soon to be 11:15) service would love to welcome you on board!

Parking - These faithful servants are typically the first faces you see on a Sunday morning, and they provide the invaluable service of making parking at Central a little easier while helping to keep us safe. They say first impressions are important, and our parking team is key to helping Central make a good one.

Gardeners - Central's gardening volunteers help maintain the various flower beds on campus. You don't have to have a green thumb, just a willingness to get your

hands dirty from time to time.

Tech arts - In addition to helping provide a great worship experience for those in attendance, the tech arts team helps share the gospel across the Internet. There is a need for both camera operators and audio techs. No experience is necessary, as we'd love to teach you how it's done.

Children's church - When the new Sunday morning schedule begins September 9, we will be introducing "children's church." During the 8:30 service only, just before the sermon begins kids in attendance ages 3 through 1st grade have the option to be dismissed for their very own time of worship. Our own Kim Burzinski will lead this time and needs someone to help her. No need to be a teacher or Bible expert, just a helping hand who loves kids.

First grade - Our children's ministry is also short one assistant leader for our first graders during the 10am Sunday school hour. As with children's church, this person is less a theologian and more a warm and caring person who cares about our kids.
