Sermon Discussion Questions for July 17, 2016

Genesis 12:1-7, Hebrews 11:8-12; "Abraham and Sarah: Faith to Follow into the Unknown"

- 1. What is the relationship between anxiety and entering the "land of the unknown"?
- 2. Give an example from your own life about your anxiety of entering your unknown?
- 3. What role did your faith play in facing this experience?
- 4. Briefly define the terms used in this message: "anthropocentric" and "theocentric."
- 5. How many times does God refer to Himself in *Genesis 12:1-3*?
- 6. How do these two perspectives affect your "world and life view" as a Christian?
- 7. Is it possible to be a Christian and yet retain an anthropocentric view on any given matter or ` issue?
- 8. Consider *Genesis 12:4*. In what way is "faith a response to God's proactive revelation"? Why is it important to God and to us to always maintain this perspective on faith?
- 9. Discuss the three dimensions of Abraham's faith (immediate, non-negotiated, unknown) as described in *Hebrews 11:8*. Do you at times display a "negotiated" faith? Provide an example of this from your own life experience? What was the result?
- 10. In what ways is faith "forward looking" (Hebrews 11:10)?
- 11. In what way was Sarah's faith "upward looking" (Hebrews 11:11)?
- 12. In what way is faith built upon the foundation of God's promises, not life appearances (*Genesis 12:7; Hebrews 11:12*)? What change might the Lord bring to your life if you lived "by promises, not appearances" [Jack Miller phrase]?
- 13. How does the gospel fulfill the promises that God made to Abraham? [Galatians 3:7-9, 29]
- 14. What is the significance of *II Corinthians* 1:19-20. How is your confidence in your future rooted in Christ and not your control? How is our confidence in our future as a congregation rooted in Christ and not our control?
