In Mission:

I'm in Guatemala as I write this report, participating in a pastor and leaders conference on Transformation. I'm leading in worship each day and doing a concert for the SETECA seminary's 86th anniversary gala. Most importantly, I'm also visiting and encouraging our EPC and Central missionaries, **Paul and Elizabeth Branch**. Central member and missionary, **Michael Miller** will join with me tomorrow for the conference and we'll have a couple of days of R & R to talk about his work in Honduras and future. It's always a joy and privilege to be with our missionaries and to pray with them and encourage them.

I will be taking a team of seven to Paris in June (14-24) for the annual Paris Prayer conference where we pray for the city and visit the work going on there. We will visit with our Central missionaries, Malia Bridwell and the Farrelly family a well.
