	Are their similarities between ancient Corinth and present day America?
	Although not absolutely certain, some notable commentators believe that when Paul arrived in <i>Corinth</i> and began his ministry there, he was most likely facing some deep, personal discouragement. What factors might have contributed to this? (five were given in the sermon). See also <i>II Corinthians 1:8-10</i> for an explicit example of Paul's self-disclosure.
